Dear Secretary Mayorkas:

We represent 75 groups, advocating for refugees and immigrants and advancing civil rights in the United States. We write regarding your <u>December 2021 commitment</u> on behalf of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to address the legal status of stateless people in the United States, and specifically, to raise our concerns that Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has failed to implement that commitment.

We commend the actions of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to implement this commitment. These include the August 2023 <u>USCIS Policy Manual</u> updates, which adopt the international definition of statelessness, addressing the legal needs of stateless people, and allow USCIS officers to consider statelessness as a positive factor in discretionary adjudications.

ICE, however, has taken no such steps, even though, in the absence of legislation, many of the hardships that stateless people experience most acutely can only be addressed by ICE. We echo the recommendations that United Stateless made in its May 16, 2024, letter. We urge ICE to implement the DHS-wide commitment to protect stateless individuals, including by:

- 1) Adopting the international definition of statelessness, as USCIS has already done: a person who is not considered as a national by any State under the operation of its law.
- 2) Train relevant ICE officers to recognize indicators of statelessness.
- 3) Ensure that statelessness is considered as a positive factor in discretionary consideration in situations where ICE officials have jurisdiction.
- 4) Address extended detention and onerous orders of supervision.
- 5) Address inadmissibility grounds under INA § 212(a)(6)(A)(i).
- 6) Collect data on stateless individuals.
